

Town of Rockland Solicitation Permits

All canvassing/soliciting must be performed in accordance with Town of Rockland By-Law Article XXV, section 25.02.

All persons requesting to obtain a solicitation permit must complete the attached APPLICATION FOR SOLICITATION PERMIT within three business days in advance of the intended solicitation dates.

Completed application must be submitted for initial approval to the Rockland Police Department licensing officer. Final approval is by the Chief of Police.

Applicant must complete and provide the following:

1. Completed application for all persons to be canvassing/soliciting.
2. Provide a valid state driver's license or other form of government identification.
3. Photographed by Rockland Police Department licensing officer.

A background investigation will be completed for all applicants.

All applicants that are approved for canvassing/solicitation will be provided with a photo identification which must be presented to all persons being solicited or upon request of any police officer.
