# Art in The Rotunda -Tracy Shankle - "This Land"

### through April 30, Reception: Wed, April 26, 6:00 PM

As a former lighting designer, Tracy appreciates how light transforms everything from color and texture to architecture and behavior. She creates images that allow viewers to step into an environment and get a sense of how a space feels. Her award-winning work has been in Boston Common magazine and internationally distributed design publications. She loves the element of surprise that comes with arriving onsite for each project.



#### About "This Land"

This work, capturing landscapes opposed to lighting and architecture, is unlike most of my other imagery. While traveling recently across the country, I was struck by the beauty of our country and noticed that the differences



from place are what stood out. Ever changing landscapes, soil colors, accents, local industries, climates, needs, and natural-disaster threats. Contrasting the unknown with what is familiar helps us make sense of the world, but it can also create a sense of "other-ness". Each state, defined by invisible lines, or a river or mountain range, reinforced this superficial separateness. This Rotunda is a Civil War Memorial, and more than 150 years later, our Nation is still polarized in many ways even though we have so much in common. Desires for good health, safety, belonging, love, understanding, community, financial security, opportunity, and self-expression - are universal. We also share this glorious land. With its vast horizons, old growth forests, geological wonders, farmlands, coastlines, and natural resources including the largest group of freshwater lakes on earth. In pausing to view and appreciate these very different landscapes, my wish is that we might also consider shifting from a mindset of our nation being one that's worth fighting for, to an outlook that our country is a land that is worth compromising, and finding the middle for. – **Tracy Shankle**






### The Friends Have Funded Summer Reading Again
