
Tiny Art - funded by The Friends On display at the Library through September





Adult Summer Reading Report from Cheryl (excerpt)

Dear Karen & Friends of Rockland Memorial Library,

Thank you for all your support for RML's 2023 Summer Reading Program!

The Adult Summer Reading Program was very successful - we had 72 adults participate and we were able to offer 8 weekly prizes and 1 grand prize thanks to your generosity. Participating adults logged 435 books, wrote 33 book reviews, and logged 97,814 minutes of reading.

Thank you for funding RML's Adult Tiny Art Show - this was how we kicked off this year's Summer Reading Program, and we received lots of enthusiastic feedback from library patrons. We gave out 50 tiny art kits and received 35 completed canvases in return. Rockland beat the average (libraries usually only receive half of the kits back - I was very happy 35 people returned them to us)! The tiny art has brightened up the library all summer, and we love seeing people stop to see them on display.

Last night we held our Tiny Art Artist Reception and 23 people attended. It was nice to see the artists and various friends/family admiring each other's work. I had many requests to do this again soon!

We all truly appreciate everything you do to support the library!


<u>Saturday Scribes: Adult Writing Group – Recommended by Friends Member John Cheney</u>
