Highway:

- 1- Road refurbishment from curb to curb is required from road utility tie in to outermost tie in. Contractor can do patches first year with full patch the following year. Contractor has the option of paying Highway/Town for refurbishment in lieu of doing said work. Cost would be established with Highway prior to work.
- 2- Drainage manholes/Catch basins will need to be updated down stream from project. Work will need to be established with Highway/Drainage departments.

Sewer:

- 1- Clay pipe will need to be replaced from Rectory/Church to go around proposed project and not underneath present school. Chain in direction manhole will be drop ins for Sewer from both project scope and Church/Rectory. Lines will need to be camera and flush upon completion. Pre camera work done by Town/Sewer.
- 2- Project will still need to come before the board for sign offs and/or approvals. Superintendent for recommendations only.
